

## CTRF – 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting June 2021

### Week 1: Prayer for Personal Revival

Throughout this time of prayer and fasting as a congregation we will be focusing on different areas of prayer for revival. In this first week we will focus on praying for personal renewal and revival. The flames of revival are lit in the hearts of individuals and then spread. It's time for us to set aside time and be intentional in seeking Him and inviting Him to do a work of preparation, restoration and revival in our hearts.

As the psalmist prayed:

***“My soul clings to the dust; Revive me according to Your word.” - Psalm 119:25 NKJV***

***“Revive me according to Your lovingkindness, So that I may keep the testimony of Your mouth.” - Psalm 119:88 NKJV***

#### **Instructions:**

As you pray each day, take time to read and meditate on the scriptures and prayer focus areas. Be attentive throughout the day and sensitive to the working of the Holy Spirit in your heart as you keep your mind stayed on Him (Isaiah 26:3, Colossians 3:1-2). Take time to worship, to be broken in His presence and to hear His voice. We encourage you to journal and write down what God is doing in your life during this time.

<b>Tuesday 6/8</b>	Repentance	<i>Isaiah 55:7-9</i> <i>Matthew 3:8-10</i> <i>Acts 3:19</i> <i>Revelation 2:5</i> <i>Revelation 3:19-20</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Forsaking our thoughts, opinions and ways and embracing His thoughts, His ways</li> <li>• Asking the Lord to "lay the axe" to the root of issues in our lives</li> <li>• Praying for times of refreshing from the Lord and His presence</li> <li>• Returning to Him, our first love</li> </ul>
<b>Wednesday 6/9</b>	Cleansing of the heart	<i>Jeremiah 17:9-10</i> <i>Psalm 139:23-24</i> <i>Psalm 32:1-5</i> <i>Psalm 51:2-3</i> <i>1 John 1:9</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inviting the Lord to search our hearts, examine us and find anything that doesn't belong and lead us in His ways.</li> <li>• Confessing our sins and receiving His forgiveness</li> <li>• Asking Him to cleanse us and wash us thoroughly</li> </ul>
<b>Thursday 6/10</b>	Surrender and Submission	<i>Psalm 37:5</i> <i>Proverbs 16:3</i> <i>Isaiah 45:9</i> <i>Isaiah 64:8</i> <i>Romans 6:16</i> <i>Romans 12:1</i> <i>James 1:23</i> <i>James 4:7</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Surrendering our hearts fully to the Lord</li> <li>• Submitting to His Lordship and the leading of His Spirit</li> <li>• Being pliable in His hand and allowing Him to shape and mold us as the potter does the clay.</li> <li>• Yielding our members to obedience to Him as living sacrifices</li> <li>• Committing to be a doer of the Word, living in obedience</li> </ul>
