We ask You to bring a visitation of Your presence to our area. Pour out Your Spirit on our neighborhoods and schools. Bring an awareness of Your presence so that people in this area would come to realize their need for You. In the mighty Name of Jesus! Amen"</i></p>
<b>Sunday 6/20</b>	Conviction of sin, righteousness and judgment	2 Chronicles 7:14 Hosea 10:12 John 16:7-11 2 Corinthians 4:3-4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Praying for conviction of the Holy Spirit in our community</li> <li>• Asking the Lord to bring the rain of His righteousness.</li> </ul>

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Binding the god of this world to lift spiritual darkness over hearts of people</li> </ul> <p><b>Prayer:</b> <i>“Lord, we humble ourselves and turn our hearts to You to ask that You would come and heal our land. Bring the rain of Your righteousness in our community. We pray for our neighbors and the people in this area that Your Spirit would convict them of sin, righteousness and judgment. We declare that the spiritual darkness over hearts is being lifted in Jesus Name and that hearts will be open to the light of Your glorious gospel!”</i></p>
<b>Monday 6/21</b>	Repentance, restoration, transformation	Psalm 80:3 Joel 2:12-14 Zechariah 1:3 2 Peter 3:9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prayer for a spirit of repentance to come upon people</li> <li>• Prayer for restoration of what the devil has destroyed in people’s lives</li> </ul> <p><b>Prayer:</b> <i>“Father, we know that it is not your will that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. It is your desire that all come to the knowledge of truth and be saved from this wicked and perverse generation. We pray the hearts of people in our area would be softened and opened to You and that people all over this region would turn and return to You. We ask for powerful conversions of souls and for many lives to be transformed in our community so that Your Name may be glorified. Amen”</i></p>
<b>Tuesday 6/22</b>	Deliverance from Oppression	Psalm 103:6 Isaiah 58:6 Luke 4:18 Acts 10:38 Ephesians 6:10-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prayer for deliverance and healing for the oppressed in our community, circle of influence</li> <li>• Praying against spiritual forces of wickedness keeping people in bondage</li> <li>• Praying for those who are captive to addictions to be set free</li> </ul> <p><b>Prayer:</b> <i>“Lord, we thank You that you are righteous in all Your ways and that You desire to deliver those who are oppressed. We pray for all those in our community who are suffering from demonic spiritual oppression, and we declare the loosing of every bond of wickedness. We ask for mighty deliverances of</i></p>

			<p><i>people bound in various addictions. We thank You for Your anointing upon us and we declare that broken hearts will be mended, captives will be released, the blind will receive sight and those who are oppressed will be set at liberty in the powerful Name of Jesus!”</i></p>
<p><b>Wednesday 6/23</b></p>	<p>Powerful witness by believers</p>	<p>Matthew 5:13-16  Mark 16:15-18  John 17:20-21  Acts 1:8  Acts 4:29-33  Romans 1:16  1 Corinthians 2:4-5</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prayer for Christians and churches all over this region to be bold in sharing the gospel and being a light to this community</li> <li>• Unity of churches and believers</li> <li>• Prayer for miracles and signs and wonders to be released</li> </ul> <p><b>Prayer:</b> <i>“Father we thank You that You have empowered us by Your Spirit to be witnesses in our families, our neighborhoods, our city, our nation and to the nations of the world. We pray for Your church in this region that You would bring us into unity with You and then into unity with one another. Let the churches in our community and region be the lights You’ve called us to be and share the gospel with boldness and without any compromise. As the disciples prayed in Acts, we ask You to extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the Name of Jesus!”</i></p>
<p><b>Thursday 6/24</b></p>	<p>Laborers for the harvest</p>	<p>Matthew 9:34-36  John 4:35</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asking the Lord for more Christian laborers to raise up more ministries in our community.</li> </ul> <p><b>Prayer:</b> <i>“Father, we want to see our community as You do – seeing the people distressed and dispirited, as sheep without a shepherd. Fill us with Your compassion for the lost and let us be compelled to go forth into the harvest to reach the lost as You’ve called us to do. You are the Lord of the harvest, so we ask You to raise up laborers in all areas of ministry in our community – jails/prisons, homeless, elderly in nursing homes, school campus ministries, to the poor, etc. Help us as Your church to equip and be equipped for the work of the ministry in this time we live in. Amen!”</i></p>

<p><b>Friday 6/25</b></p>	<p>Open doors for Christian ministry</p>	<p>Matthew 16:19          Acts 14:27          1 Corinthians 16:8-9          Colossians 4:2-4</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Praying for open doors of opportunity for new ministries in our community</li> <li>• Praying against opposition and resistance to the gospel being preached</li> </ul> <p><b>Prayer:</b> <i>“Lord, we acknowledge that apart from You we can do nothing, but that through You nothing is impossible. Only You can open doors that no man can shut, so we ask for Your favor for open doors of opportunity for the gospel to be declared and shared in our community. There are many people who are suffering behind closed doors. Help us to reach them with Your love. We bind every hindrance and opposition to the gospel and declare that doors be opened! We give You praise and say Yours is the kingdom, the power and the glory, AMEN!”</i></p>
